

Art of Adornment: Conditions for Entry

Eligibility: Cornucopia Art Center's "Art of Adornment" exhibition is open to all artists living in North America who design and produce their own work. The work must have been completed within the last two years and not previously shown in Southeastern Minnesota.

All work entered must be made available if accepted. No substitutions will be allowed. Failure to meet this requirement will result in disqualification of the artist and the work. Cornucopia Art Center reserves the right to refuse works that fail to meet the quality represented in the slides.

Size and Weight Limits: Each accepted piece must be contained in an exterior shipping box not greater than 2'h x 2'w x 2'd and 50 lbs.

Juror: Cornucopia Art Center is honored to have Elizabeth Bucheit as juror. Bucheit is a metalsmith, teacher and curator who resides in Lanesboro, MN. One of only four American finalists in the 2002 Gold Virtuosi Design Competition, Bucheit has also been recognized by the Minnesota State Arts Board with a 2005 Artist Initiative Fellowship.

Slides: Each artist may enter up to 3 works. Artwork will be juried from slides (2" x 2" 35mm) or digital files (jpg/tif/kodak shareware compatible) on CD. Slides must be clearly marked with the artists name, title, medium, size (HxWxD), date of completion and entry number. CD's must be clearly marked with the artists name, titles of contained images, and entry number. All slides/CD's will become the property of Cornucopia Art Center.

Shipping & Liability: Accepted artists may hand deliver or ship their work and will receive instruction. Artists are responsible for shipping and insurance to and from the exhibition. Cornucopia Art Center will insure the work for the duration of the exhibition for 50% of fair market value.

Sales: Sales are encouraged. A 40% commission on work sold will be deducted from retail sales price to benefit the programs of Cornucopia Art Center.
