

## 2012 National Juried High School Metals Exhibition

The Fine Arts Center, a preeminent fine arts magnet high school in Greenville, SC, invites high school teachers and students to submit their best high school student artwork made in the mediums of metal, jewelry, and enamel for exhibition the Sheffield Wood Gallery. The goal is to make this an eagerly-anticipated biennial event that highlights the accomplishments of students and teachers at the high school level, to showcase how these media can be used to achieve artistic expression, and to generate interest in and excitement about the fields of metals and enameling.

### ELIGIBILITY

- Work eligible for submission includes all types of metalsmithing, including jewelry, vessels, objects, enameling, etc. Work must be original creative expressions, avoid cliché, and demonstrate excellence in design and execution. Mixed media pieces will be considered as long as metal is the primary material. **Work must be made within the last three years during high school.** *Ineligibly* will extend to any work made while the student earns college credit, for instance, a “post-secondary” class.
- **Open to all high school students and recent graduates.** Those making metalwork as part of a class at a public or private high school ARE eligible, as ARE students making work in a home studio, taking private art lessons, or attending classes at art centers or “young artist” programs taking place at colleges. High School teachers are encouraged to send entries from their school together on one cd.

### JUROR

**Robert Ebendorf**, an esteemed metalsmith, jeweler, and leader in the American studio jewelry movement. He is one of the founding members of the Society of North American Goldsmiths (SNAG), is an inductee of the National Metalsmiths Hall of Fame, and has had his own retrospective at the Smithsonian American Art Museum. He has been awarded a Fulbright Scholar Grant and a Louis Comfort Tiffany Foundation Grant, and is currently the Belk Distinguished Professor of Art at East Carolina University in North Carolina.

### AWARDS

\$1000 in cash prizes will be awarded. All exhibiting students will receive a certificate of participation.

### ENTRY FEE

There is **no entry fee** for this exhibition. However, entrants must pay for and arrange their own shipping and insurance to and from the exhibition.

ENTRY FORM for the 2012 NATIONAL JURIED HIGH SCHOOL METALS EXHIBITION

1. A student may enter up to three artworks; there are no limits of entries per teacher. Teachers are encouraged to put multiple students entry images on one cd. (A student may enter without the aid of a teacher by inputting parent's name and address in teacher/school slots and writing the venue where the metalwork was made in the High School Name slot.)
2. Entries must be submitted as digital images in JPEG format on a CD. **Image size should be no more than 500 pixels for the longer dimension.** Label JPEGs as [HighSchoolInitials][studentsastname][entrynumber].jpg. Example: FACcassell1.jpg. One detail image per entry is allowed; label by adding an "a" to the end of file name, i.e.: FACcassell1a.jpg
2. Fill in the table below. Save as a word doc filed named [HighSchoolInitials]entry.doc (ex: FACentry.doc) and burn onto cd along with images. Also print out a hard copy and mail with cd.
