Deadline

All materials must be received by March 15, 2006.

Notification

Winners will be notified by the end of May 2006.

Award Criteria

Awards will be based on the strength of applicants work, intended course of study, academic achievement and letters of recommendation.

Eligibility

Applicant must be enrolled in a Jewelry or Metals program for the upcoming year. The program is not limited to university programs. If you are uncertain of your eligibility you may contact the EES coordinator at ben@benneubauer.com.

APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE ONE OF EACH OF THE FOLLOWING

Transcript

One copy of a transcript from the educational institution you are currently attending.

Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope

Provide one large envelope with sufficient postage for return of your **slides only**. Please use your permanent mailing address to insure the safe return of your materials. SNAG will not be responsible for slides that are not returned due to insufficient postage or packaging. Slides from winning grant recipients will become part of the SNAG audio-visual library.

APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE THREE COMPLETE SETS OF APPLICATION MATERIALS LISTED BELOW.

Each set must be presented in a separate two pocket folder with your name clearly written on the front of each folder. Do not bind, use brads or staple your materials. All forms should be typewritten. Incomplete, late or incorrectly submitted/packaged applications will be returned without consideration.

Typed Application Form

All sections must be completed. List most recent information first. Must be typewritten. The completed application form must be signed.

Resume

Artist Statement

Please limit this to one typewritten page.

Set of slides (read carefully)

Applicants must include a **MINIMUM of 5 slides. DO NOT include more than 8 slides.**

Images MUST consist of AT LEAST 4 completed pieces. Number each slide to correspond with your slide list.

Label each with name, title, date, materials, and dimensions. Indicate top and present in a slide sheet.

Slide list

The list should have your name at the top and correspond to your numbered slides including title, date, materials, and dimensions of each piece.

Reference

The list should have your name at the top and consist of one name, include position, academic affiliation addresses and telephone numbers of the person submitting a letter of recommendation.

One confidential letter of recommendation

Letter of recommendation should be signed and sealed. Reference must be mailed with your application. Please ask reference to write a concise, detailed and candid letter.
