MISSION: The Michigan Silversmiths Guild (MSG) was founded in 1948. Guild members include craftpersons proficient in the fields of metalsmithing and jewelry, and serves to broaden the knowledge of its members' craft and to facilitate communication with other metalsmiths.

In accordance with this mission MSG and the Ann Arbor South University Area Association will sponsor two booths at the 2008 South University Art Fair. This event will focus on working with a community of fellow metalsmiths/jewelers to create an understanding of what it means to be part of an art fair and to broaden our ability to demonstrate and communicate our craft to a wider audience. Through this event we will broaden our collective understanding of this multi faceted activity.

ELIGIBILITY: All MSG members are eligible to apply. All work submitted must be made by the applicant, some metal is a must. Members who are interested in learning about art fairs or may be considering this as a career path who may not have ever shown at an art fair before are especially encouraged to apply. If you are not a member or are not current with your dues please fill out the guild membership form available on our web site (misilversmith.org).

ABOUT THE JURORS:

Ann E. Kuffler is the Director and owner of Ariana Gallery in Royal Oak, Michigan. Ariana Gallery, which has been in operation since 1987, showcases a variety of both decorative and functional work by local and international artists. Ann is also a professional art consultant and artist, her previous juring experience includes the Hotworks Fine Art Shows, Birmingham Fine Art Festival, and the Ann Arbor Art Fair.

Fredrick "Skip" Hunter currently serves as historian for the Michigan Silversmiths Guild. Fredrick was the head of the metals/jewelry department at Eastern Michigan University for over 35 years. He received a master's degree in fine arts from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

ENTRY PROCEDURE: This call for entry is specifically for selling work at the SU Art Fair. Submit up to 5 images of your work by CD along with the call for entry form, \$25 application fee, and a stamped envelope for notification. All images submitted will become property of MSG and will be used for publicity purposes, therefore do not send original images please. **Applications are due February 18th, 2008.**

Images should be representative of the body of work you plan to sell at the MSG booth.

Format:
Digital images may be submitted in CD format. TIFF and JGP files at 300 dpi only. Files should be no larger than 10 MB. Digital images must be labeled last name and entry number.

Ex. **Smith1.jpg.**

CD's need to be labeled with the artist's name, address, and phone number.

Exhibition Rules:

Accepted artists are required to work together as a group to carry out all aspects of the art fair. Tasks will include setting up monthly meetings to establish a system for inventory, accepting currency, creating all necessary publicity, along with contacting additional volunteers for booth sitting. One member from the group will be selected as the chair person of the committee. This person will be responsible for communicating with the MSG Board.

Shipping, Liability, and Sales:
MSG does not provide insurance; each artist is responsible for their own insurance and will be asked to sign a waiver. Instructions for submitting work will be included in the acceptance letter. MSG will not take a commission, however there will be a booth fee (estimated at \$100 per accepted artist) to cover expenses payable upon acceptance.
