The Guild sponsors lectures, demonstrations, and workshops by artists and teachers established in their fields. The Guild also sponsors juried exhibitions of work produced by its members. Workshops are held at various locations including the College for Creative Studies, Eastern Michigan University, University of Michigan, Bowling Green State University, Wayne State University and the Ann Arbor Art Center. 

His work is included in a variety of collections and has been shown quite extensively in an array of exhibitions throughout the country.

Media

Original jewelry, sculpture, holloware, flatware, decorative or functional objects executed in precious and non-precious metals alone or in combination with other materials are eligible.

Sales

The Ann Arbor Art Center will charge a commission of 50% of sales resulting from the exhibit.

Awards

Over \$1000 in awards will be presented.

Entries

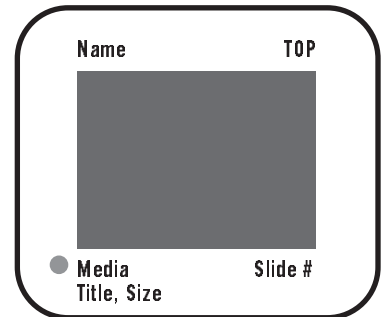
Entrants must be current members of the Michigan Silversmiths Guild. Please include \$25 for up to three entries. If you are not a current member, include an additional check of \$25 for membership; for students with proper I.D. include a \$10 membership fee. All work must be original, completed within the last three years and not previously submitted to this competition. All forms must be completed to insure correct identification, pricing and notification. Please indicate your permanent address for return of work.

Liability

The Ann Arbor Art Center will insure all artwork for breakage and theft only. The Ann Arbor Art Center and the Michigan Silversmiths Guild are not responsible for items in transit. Each artist is responsible for any additional insurance. Please insure your work in transit. Artists are responsible for returned work.

Entry Procedure

1. Artists may submit up to 3 pieces.
2. Entries will be juried from 35mm slides or digital images sent in jpeg format on CD. Do not send original slides or digital images. Slides and images of accepted work will be retained for publicity purposes.
3. Slide entries—Mark your professional quality slides as follows (no glass mounts please):
 - Name of artist
 - "TOP"
 - Red dot in bottom left corner
 - Slide # in bottom right corner
 - Media, dimensions and title



4. Digital entries:
 - Artist name on CD
 - Image file numbered and titled
 - Fill out entry card
