**MISSION:** The Michigan Silversmiths Guild (MSG) was founded in 1948. Guild members include craftpersons proficient in the fields of metalsmithing and jewelry, and serves to broaden the knowledge of its members' craft and to facilitate communication with other metalsmiths.

In accordance with this mission MSG and the Ann Arbor South University Area Association will sponsor two booths at the 2007 South University Art Fair. This event will focus on working with a community of fellow metalsmiths/jewelers to create an understanding of what it means to be part of an art fair and to broaden our ability do demonstrate and communicate our craft to a wider audience. Through this event we will broaden our collective understanding of this multi faceted activity.

**ELIGIBILITY:** All MSG members are eligible to apply. All work submitted must be made by the applicant, some metal is a must. If you are not a member or are not current with your dues please fill out the guild membership form available on our web site (misilversmith.org).

**ENTRY PROCEDURE:** This call for entry is specifically for demonstrating techniques at the SU Art Fair, Submit up to 5 images of your work by CD along with the call for entry form, up to a one page description of demonstration, and a stamped envelope for notification. All images submitted will become property of MSG, do not send original images please. **Applications must be postmarked by May 21st, 2007.**

Images should be of exhibition style work that demonstrates the techniques you plan to demonstrate, work should also be available the days of the art fair to have on display ( they will be kept under a vatrine on a pedestal during the day/s you demonstrate and taken off premises during the evening hours)

Digital Formatting:

Digital images may be submitted in CD format. TIFF and JGP files at 300 dpi only. Files should be no larger than 10 MB. Digital images must be labeled last name and entry number.

Ex. **Smith1.jpg.**

Cd's need to be labeled with the artists name, address, and phone number.

**Demonstrator Rules:** All proposed demonstrations must use tools that the demonstrator will be able to bring to the art fair and take home during the evening. The guild will provide a workbench for demos and a stool everything else will be the artists responsibility. **No open flames are allowed at the art fair so please plan demo accordingly.**

Accepted Artists Are Required to be present for the full day of their demonstration at the art fair. Arrive by 8:00 am and stay till 9:30 pm. Artists may not leave until the end of the day, except for special emergencies.

Accepted Artists are required to booth-sit, along with MSG members who were accepted for the sales portion of the event, for other Ann Arbor Art Fair vendors during your scheduled day/s.

Accepted artists are invited to create work for sale to sell during the course of the day they demonstrate.

**Shipping, Liability, and Sales:** Accepted artists must hand deliver their work pre- tagged and inventoried June 30th or July 1st . Instructions on how to tag, price, and inventory work will be enclosed in the acceptance letters. Further instructions will be explained at the fair. **MSG does not provide insurance; each artist is responsible for their own insurance and will be asked to sign a waiver.** There are no fees associated with demonstrating or selling work.
