**MISSION:** The Michigan Silversmiths Guild (MSG) was founded in 1948. Guild members include craftpersons proficient in the fields of metalsmithing and jewelry, and serves to broaden the knowledge of its members' craft and to facilitate communication with other metalsmiths.

In accordance with this mission MSG and the Ann Arbor South University Area Association will sponsor two booths at the 2007 South University Art Fair. This event will focus on working with a community of fellow metalsmiths/jewelers to create an understanding of what it means to be part of an art fair and to broaden our ability do demonstrate and communicate our craft to a wider audience. Through this event we will broaden our collective understanding of this multi faceted activity.

**ELIGIBILITY:** All MSG members are eligible to apply. All work submitted must be made by the applicant, some metal is a must. Members who are interested in learning about art fairs or may be considering this as a career path who may not have ever shown at an art fair before are especially encouraged to apply. #### **ABOUT THE JURORS:**

**Peggy Kerr** is currently the Gallery Shop Director at the Birmingham Bloomfield Art Center. Peggy is also the coordinator for the Birmingham Fine Art Festival. Peggy has jurred for numerous art events state wide, including the Art on the Green in Franklin Village.

**Evan Larson** is currently an Assistant Professor of Metalsmithing at Wayne State University in Detroit, Michigan. He is a recipient of a Fulbright Research Grant to Korea. Evan received his BFA from University of Wisconsin Milwaukee and his MFA from Cranbrook Academy of Art. His work has been included in many national and international venues such as, the "Internationalen Handwerksmesse" in Munich, Germany, the San Francisco Craft & Folk Art Museum. Evan has given many lectures and demonstrations at Universities across the United States, Korea and China.

**ENTRY PROCEDURE:** This call for entry is specifically for selling work at the SU Art Fair, see demonstration call for entry if you are interested in demonstrating or volunteering. Submit up to 5 images of your work by slide or CD along with the call for entry form, \$25 application fee, and a stamped envelope for notification. All images submitted will become property of MSG, do not send original images please. **Applications must be postmarked by March 18th, 2007.**

Images should be representative of the body of work you plan to sell at the MSG booth.

Digital Format:

Digital images may be submitted in CD format. TIFF and JGP files at 300 dpi only. Files should be no larger than 10 MB. Digital images must be labeled last name and entry number.

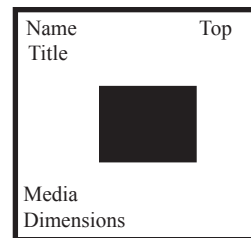

Cd's need to be labeled with the artists name, address, and phone number.

Slide Format:

Slide images need to be 35mm film in 2"x2" mountes (no glass covers please). Each slide needs to be labeled with the following information:

- Top
- Name
- Title
- Material
- Size



#### **Exhibition Rules:**

Accepted Artists Are Required to participate for at least two days during the art fair. Arrive by 8:00 am and stay till 9:30 pm. Artists may not leave until the end of the day, except for special emergencies. Represent your work and the work of others' at the MSG booth. Booth-sit for other Ann Arbor Art Fair vendors during your scheduled days.

**Shipping, Liability, and Sales:** Accepted artists must hand deliver their work pre- tagged and inventoried June 30th or July 1st . Instructions on how to tag, price, and inventory work will be enclosed in the acceptance letters. Further instructions will be explained at the fair. **MSG does not provide insurance; each artist is responsible for their own insurance and will be asked to sign a waiver.** MSG will not take a commission, however there will be a booth fee (estimated at \$100 per accepted artist) to cover expenses payable upon acceptance.
