## Tessellation with Julia Woodman

### Biography:

Julia Woodman completed a master of fine arts degree in metalsmithing at Georgia State University and subsequently won a Fulbright fellowship for study in Finland where she was certified as a master silversmith. Her work is in the collections of the Victoria and Albert Museum (London), Cathedral of St. Philip (Atlanta), Temple Sinai (Atlanta), and Georgia State University. She is currently teaching at The Spruill Center for the Arts in Atlanta Georgia.



**Workshop Description:** Tessellation is the construction of many small cut and formed pieces of metal to create 3-D shapes. These constructions contain space, expose light and cast color by reflection. In this workshop Julia will teach the construction of discs, squares or jump rings into 3-D units which are then assembled to create a larger single unit. This type of construction using negative and positive spaces, gives the effect of volume while simultaneously limiting the weight of the piece. Tessellation can be used in construction of bracelets, earring and spoon handles. **Bring your imagination and an optivisor and let's play.**
